WHEREAS, in the previous resolution the payment would have been made to Netcong directly,

WHEREAS, the revised resolution will need to reference that the payment will be made directly to the vendor;

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education accepts the recommendation of the Superintendent to approve a shared services agreement with Netcong Board of Education, Morris County NJ to provide Counseling Coaching and Certification for the 2021-2022 school year with an option to extend for the 2022-2023 school year. Furthermore, the provided services will be funded through the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSERII) Fund not to exceed the allocation amount of \$45,000. Netcong Board of Education will be soliciting RFP for Counseling Coaching and Certification Services for both Board of Educations, however; the Mine Hill Township Board of Education will be submitting payment directly to the vendor.
